Tactical Rifle Instructor December 9-13, 2024

Course Description:

This course will provide students with the information and hands-on experience needed to effectively instruct in the use of a patrol rifle, in a law enforcement setting. This course will satisfy California POST requirements to instruct in the use of a patrol rifle (AR-15/M4), to include short barrel rifles as specified in Penal Code Section 33220(b).

Students are required to qualify with their dept-issued patrol rifle on the first day of class. The qualification course will be provided before the course begins, giving students time to practice and prepare for the courses of fire. Failure to qualify will be grounds for dismissal from the course. A written test will be administered at the end of Day 5.

Prerequisite: This course is not designed as an introduction to the patrol rifle. The student should have completed a POST certified basic rifle course prior to enrolling in the Patrol Rifle Instructor Course.

- Attire:** BDU-style or utility-style clothing are acceptable. Shirts may not contain offensive language or logos. Footwear should be tactical in nature. Footwear. Clothing appropriate for participation in exercises utilizing Simunitions (long sleeves, etc.) should be considered.
